If you opt for Assisted Living, a face-to-face meeting follows at which we plan a detailed set of actions and objectives. Known as the Help Plan Process, we agree in this the specifics of the assistance to be provided and the number of hours involved. Throughout the period of assistance you have a personal point of contact available to you, who has specialist training and can help with any issues.

The services provided are an income-dependent provision. Where income is low there is the possibility of costs being covered by the social welfare agency.
